Position Summary:	<p>Seeking a Center Media Intern to assist with pre-production, production and postproduction of the Center's TV show, 'Out at the Center.' The intern works with and trains volunteer producers in basic camera and editing of segments, shepherding segments through production. The intern is able to do anything that is needed for a grassroots community media show from dubbing a DVD window burn, to color correcting an episode for online distribution, to helping a segment team light an interview. A very competent intern can even earn an associate producer credit for the TV show and produce important public service announcements to add to their reel.</p> <p>The intern must be able to do the internship for college credit. The intern must have experience shooting with a 3-chip digital video camera. The intern must have experience editing with Final Cut Pro and be Mac proficient. It is helpful to have experience teaching and/or working with volunteers. Great communication skills, an upbeat attitude and a commitment to LGBT issues are also important.</p> <p>Internships are part-time, from June through August 2008, and September through December 2008.</p>
